



Richard Dickason, CEO

For more than four decades, CEO, Rich Dickason has been a driving force behind Exchange Bank's success and expansion. In 2018, he celebrates 45 years of hard work and innovation with the bank.

After graduating from the University of Kansas, Rich began a career as a certified public accountant for the Touche Ross Accounting Firm, which later brought him to Atchison. In 1973, after performing the audit of Exchange National Bank, Rich was offered a job as controller by the bank's owner and president, John Adair, Sr. John saw Rich's potential as a leader and in 1978 recommended him as his predecessor. Rich served as president for 29 years, second only to William Hetherington, the bank's founder who served for 31 years. He stepped down as president in 2007 and Mark Windsor took the helm. He has, however, remained CEO and keeps an active role in the day-to-day operations of the bank. His love for Atchison is evident in the many organizations he has served and charitable contributions he's made to the community.
